
Second Edition of City and Peninsula

When the Christ-church and Akaroa Civic Trusts co-operated in 2007 to publish City and Peninsula, their goals were to show off the region's rich heritage to visitors from overseas and to encourage local people to protect that heritage. Neither Trust dreamt that four years later they would be publishing a second edition of the book with an entirely different purpose – as a record of heritage that has been almost entirely lost. The book is now an incomparable record of the heritage of Christchurch, Lyttelton and Akaroa before that heritage was diminished by the earthquakes and the demolitions that followed. It is a reminder of what we once had – an architecture that spoke of the region's past and of aesthetic pleasures of brick, limestone, and Gothic and Classical detailing. Nobody will ever build like that again.
